

A Message from our Senior Pastor

Dear CCC Friends and Family,

Some days, the role of a pastor is project manager. In today's article, I want to share with you a number of upcoming events and pieces of information vital to the life of our Community:

July 9th-12th: Vacation Bible School. Thank you to our leaders and volunteers for helping make this possible. The seeds of faith that are planted in our children will hopefully grow and develop throughout the entirety of their lives. For some of our young ones, this will be the week where they grow most deeply in their faith.

July 15th: Laura McDurmont will update the congregation, following worship, with a brief summary of the overall vision and mission statement, dream team summaries, and possible fiscal plans for the following year.

July 22nd: Don Miller and Normal Pereira will begin leading a three session Bible study examining texts of the Bible that address issues of homosexuality. As Christians, we take seriously the texts of the Bible and the role/authority of the Bible in our lives. The goal of the study is not to persuade one way or another, but rather to do serious study of our sacred texts and reflect on how these passages influence our understandings of faith.

July 22nd: John Yonker will be leading our service and worship. I will be out of town for our annual summer vacation to Colorado.

July 29th: The Core Leadership Team will be leading worship as the girls and I make our way back across the plains of Kansas.

August 5th: Following worship, we will have an official vote on whether to accept our new mission and vision statements. Note, we are still accepting feedback. Overall, we have received positive feedback following the original revisions. Don and Norm will lead the second session of their class.

August 7th: Stable Sale begins. Since 2007, the Stable sale has given \$333,400 towards debt retirement for the Wunderlich building, \$168,067 in outreach, and thousands of dollars each year in non-budgeted church items such as special facility projects, mission projects, project discretionary money, outreach money and scholarships.

August 12th: Don and Norm will lead their final Bible study.

August 19th: We will celebrate Sarah's final Sunday at Community. While we wish her the very best, we're sad to see her go. We are currently interviewing candidates for this position.

It will be, and has been, a busy summer. We have celebrated two gorgeous weddings (with one more in August), welcomed new friends in worship, remembered the lives of faithful saints, and have been blessed with wonderful and engaging worship and music.

Our overall financial picture as of June 30th is very close to what was anticipated. Reduced offering has been offset by higher revenue from rental of the WFLC and lower than anticipated expenses.

Later this month we will be replacing the nearly 20 year old air conditioning and furnace units that cool and heat the sanctuary, with an expected cost of nearly \$11,000.

Your continued support of CCC helps to maintain our church property and provide ministry to many in our area and beyond.

Several members from CCC, along with family members of Loyalty and Don Miller, spent all or part of the week of June 24th in Van Buren, MO helping several families rebuild their homes after damaging floods that took place early in 2017. Water from the Current River went uphill for more than 1/2 mile to damage most of the town. Total cost of the destruction has been estimated at \$13 million, including the complete loss of the church pictured above. It has not been replaced due to lack of funds. Catholic Charities has organized for the reconstruction effort on the homes the team from CCC worked on.
